

### INTRODUCTION

This report highlights the projects the County Government has implemented in the first year of H.E. Patrick Ole Ntutu's Administration. It results from an inclusive and collective approach to addressing the needs of the people in Narok County. It is also a product of a collaboration between the County Executive and County Assembly that has seen each ward receive Sh100 million for development and critical recurrent expenditure. It is worth noting that the Sh3 billion budgetary allocation is from the County's revenue.



### A PARTICIPATORY APPROACH TO DEVELOPMENT

The two arms of the County Government of Narok embarked on a transformative partnership that earmarked Sh100 million per ward to drive development and fund critical recurrent expenditures prioritised by the people during public participation. Below is a step-by-step account of the journey that preceded the implementation of the projects.



The approach was anchored on the participatory model of development and the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation Agenda.

### **Enoosaen Health Centre**

The project involves the completion of a kitchen, laundry unit and staff house, which started around 2009, with the Africa Development Bank's support. The additional facilities complement the existing units and help cater for a fast-growing population in and around Enoosaen Trading Centre, which has registered tremendous growth due to the introduction of sugarcane farming in the area.

### **Nentekeny Dispensary**

The construction of the Nentekeny Dispensary is at an advanced stage. The structure of the outpatient unit is complete, with work going on for the auxiliary units, such as toilets, an incinerator and a connection to water and electricity. Residents have in the past been forced to travel to faraway health facilities such as Nkararo, and the completion and operationalisation of the new facility will enable them to receive timely medical attention.

This road is important as it links Oldanyati and Kiikat to Ogwedhi, which is one of the centres in the region with an integral livestock market. The linking bridge is under construction as the rest of the road is utilised.







# Separated by geography, united by drops of life

Nkineji is located in Siana Ward, where the two main economic activities are tourism and livestock keeping. Ilmotiok village lent its name to the ward stretching to Oloonkerin in the Loita plains. Both areas receive little rainfall and are prone to occasional dry spells when access to clean water becomes challenging. Residents have to trek long distances to water their livestock and fetch some for domestic use. In the case of Ilmotiok, most residents have had to water their animals at Amalo River, a considerable distance from their homes. The Ilmotiok Primary School borehole has a watering point for every villager and pupil and water troughs for livestock. Such is the case at the Nkineji/Oiti borehole. These projects have brought clean and safe drinking water closer to the people of Nkineji and Ilmotiok. They will, therefore, lower the rate of waterborne diseases and, as a result, lighten the burden on public health.

## name

Koitiko Primary School is located in Mosiro Ward, Narok East Constituency. It has 25 pupils living with different types of disabilities. The number is vastly increasing because of the school's open-door policy. Since noting that the school has accepted physically and mentally challenged pupils, community members are now enrolling their children. However, teachers say most children have been abandoned, and the school administration left to its own devices. Some pupils need constant medication, while others need devices such as wheelchairs.

On the bright side, integration is slowly taking root in the school, as was evident in the relations among the pupils. Therefore, the dormitory under construction will provide the much-needed shelter and foster integration.

## **Suswa Dispensary**

This is an existing facility that, until December 2022, was run for profit. The County Government took over the facility and equipped the outpatient, maternal and child health and the male and female wards. The pharmacy is well stocked.



## **Dry Port-Suswa Water Project**

The Project sources water from the Dry Port in Naivasha. Suswa is arid and characterised by porous and loose soil that cannot hold water, ruling out digging dams and pans. Further, groundwater is poor, and one is likely to strike dry wells as it is mainly a geothermal area. Given this, the residents go through great difficulties sourcing water. Therefore, The County Government tapped water from Mt. Longonot serving the EPZ Dry Port in Naivasha to allow Suswa residents to access water in close proximity to alleviate their suffering. The water project covers piping and metering. The is 70% done, with 240 households already connected. The project will be handed over to the Narok Water Company for management upon completion.
