

TALK POINTS FOR HIS EXCELLENCY GOVERNOR PATRICK OLE NTUTU DURING THE MEETING WITH THE NARWASSCO BOARD MEMBERS

12th April, 2023

KEY ISSUES UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR THE MEETING

1. Status of Narok Water and Sewerage Services Company Limited

The company has made significant strides in improving access to safe water and sanitation services in the county.

However, there are still some issues of concern that need to be addressed to improve the company's operations.

2. Issues of Concern

- 1. Electricity and Chemical Subsidy:** The high cost of electricity and chemicals is a major challenge facing NARWASSCO. The company needs support to subsidize the cost of these essential items.
- 2. Rehabilitation of Ilmashariani Spring:** The Ilmashariani Spring needs urgent rehabilitation to increase water supply to the surrounding areas. A quick intervention is needed to transfer the transformer closer to the pump and a complete overhaul of the water supply system.
- 3. Drilling and Equipping of Ntulele WSTF Borehole:** The drilling and equipping of the Ntulele WSTF Borehole will increase water supply to the surrounding areas.
- 4. Rehabilitation of Vertical Treatment Plant at the Central Treatment Plant:** The rehabilitation of the Vertical Treatment Plant at the Central Treatment Plant is critical to improving water treatment.
- 5. Company Policies** to be reviewed on Human Resource Policies, Financial Policies, Procurement Policies, IT Policies.

3. Company Future Plans

1. Expansion of Ololulunga Town Water Supply System: NARWASSCO plans to expand the Ololulunga Town Water Supply System to improve water supply to the area.
2. Taking Over of Kilgoris-Lolgorian Water Supply Project: The Company plans to take over the Kilgoris-Lolgorian Water Supply Project to improve water supply to the surrounding areas.
3. Taking Over of Suswa Town Dry-Port Water Supply Project: NARWASSCO also plans to take over the Suswa Town Dry-Port Water Supply Project to improve water supply to the area.
4. Upper Narok Dam: The construction of the Upper Narok Dam will increase water supply to the county and improve the operations of NARWASSCO.
