The members present introduced themselves stating the various groups they represent. There was representation from the Narok chamber of commerce, Nyumba Kumi Initiative, and National Government Administration.

The Board members followed suit stating the various associations they represent and positions they hold in the Board as well,

MIN NCG-MNCF/07/30/05/2024/03 MUNICIPALITY OF NAROK ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN FOR FY 2024/2025

The Municipality citizens were called upon to make proposals for inclusion in the Municipality's development plans and also react to the implementation status of the projects for action by the Board.

The representatives of the various groups made the following proposals and suggestions to the Board;

- a) Mitigation by the Municipal Board on the issues of insecurity in certain areas of the Municipality.
- b) Setting up sensitization forums by the Board on livestock development to promote the agricultural sector.

- c) Establishment of a meat processing factory within the Municipality to create job/business opportunities for the residents of the Municipality.
- d) Establishment of a Maasai market in the Municipality appreciating the need to create business opportunities for the residents of the Municipality.
- e) Creating of a recreational park within the Town Center as well as shades to beautify the town and also serve as areas where residents can retreat for breaks during their daily activities.
- f) Rehabilitation and development of the existing markets as well as ensuring that the markets are equipped with the relevant services such washrooms, water supply, etc.
- g) Putting in place of measures necessary to curb disorderliness within the Municipality ranging from disorganised business practices, traffic, grazing of cows in town, etc.
- h) Consideration of the construction of a cemetery to serve the Municipality.
- i) Implementation of the existing plans to ensure the sprawling slums are contained.
- j) Designating areas for mtumba vending to ensure orderliness.
- k) Mitigating on the drug abuse menace by promotion of the measures the relevant agencies have put in place within the Municipality.
- l) Promotion of environmental safe measures and particularly ensuring that quarrying activities are regulated within the Municipality.
- m) Improvement of existing roads by providing the necessary road furniture such as bumps and footpaths.
- n) Construction of Motobike sheds to ensure orderliness and provide shelter to these operators.

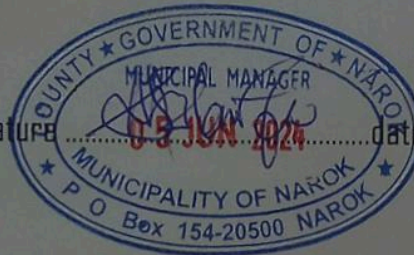
There being no any other business the meeting was adjourned at 03.00 pm after a word of prayer by Ms. Fridah Nyala
